Annual Report of Sexual Assault Data Findings and Corrective Actions

I. Introduction

The Prince William- Manassas Regional Detention Center (PWMRADDC) has a zero-tolerance policy toward sexual abuse and sexual harassment in our facilities. The Adult Detention Center will comply and enforce all federal, state and local laws pertaining sexual abuse. The agency is committed to the prevention, detection, response and investigation of sexual misconduct.

This collection of information is compared to previous years' data and utilized by the Department's Prison Rape Elimination Act Coordinators to identify potential issues or areas of concern and formulate corrective responses to reduce victimization of sexual abuse.

The data collected is also available for use by the US Department of Justice for completion of the Survey of Sexual Violence (SSV).

This report has been approved by the Superintendent and all data in this report will be maintained on the website for at least ten years after the date of the initial collection.

II. Prevention

All reports will be fully investigated, which includes allegations of sexual abuse and sexual harassment, by the Internal Affairs Division of the Prince William-Manassas Regional Adult Detention Center and/or the Prince William County Police Department.

In compliance with the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) standards we have implemented several procedures for the prompt reporting of allegations of alleged sexual offenses.

Inmates may report instances of non-consensual sexual acts, abusive sexual contacts, staff sexual misconduct, or staff sexual harassment, to any staff member, volunteer or contact worker or third party. The inmate may do this verbally, or in writing. Inmates have the ability to use grievances, request forms and confidential reporting hotlines to report any instances of sexual abuse and rape within the jail. All efforts will be made to ensure the confidentiality of the reporting inmate.

III. Education

The agency has taken a pro-active stance in educating all visitors, contractors, volunteers and vendors that are in contact with the inmate population. All Adult Detention Center staff have been trained in prevention, detection and investigation of sexual related incidents. The inmates are also educated to their rights to be free of any form of sexual abuse. Any substantiated instances of sexual abuse relating to inmate to inmate, staff/volunteer/vendor/contractor to inmate will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law as well as any false allegations of sexual abuse.

IV. Definitions

Rape or Sexual Assault: (a) the carnal knowledge, oral sodomy, sexual assault with an object, or sexual fondling of a person, forcibly or against that person's will; (b) the carnal knowledge, oral sodomy, sexual assault with an object, or sexual fondling of a person, not forcibly or against that person's will, where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his or her youth or his or her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity; or (c) the carnal knowledge, oral sodomy, sexual assault with an object, or sexual fondling of a person achieved through the exploitation of the fear or threat of physical violence or bodily injury.

In accordance with PREA, all investigations are assigned one of three determinations:

Substantiated: an allegation which was investigated and determined to have occurred.

Unfounded: an allegation which was investigated and determined not to have occurred.

Unsubstantiated: an allegation which produced insufficient evidence to make a final determination of a substantiated or unfounded claim.

V. Data

2017

On December 31, 2017, the daily population was 965 inmates

- The investigations revealed that no corrective measures were necessary. Staff followed policy and procedures.

2018

- In the year of 2018, there were no substantiated allegations of Inmate-on-Inmate sexual assaults.
- In the year of 2018, there were 3 unsubstantiated allegations of Inmate-on-Inmate sexual assaults.
- In the year of 2018, there were no substantiated or unsubstantiated allegations of Staff-on-Inmate sexual assaults.

Data in this report reflects calendar year 2018: January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018

On December 31, 2018, the daily population was 924 inmates

The average daily population for the Prince William-Manassas Regional ADC in 2018 was 986

There were 10,007 commitments to the Prince William-Manassas Regional ADC in 2018

Corrective measures that were taken in 2018 for the 3 unsubstantiated allegations of Inmate-on-Inmate sexual assaults consisted of:

- The investigations revealed that no corrective measures were necessary. Staff followed policy and procedures.

2019

- In the year of 2019, there was 1 substantiated allegation of Inmate-on-Inmate sexual assault.
- In the year of 2019, there was 1 unsubstantiated allegation of Inmate-on-Inmate sexual assault.
- In the year of 2019, there were no substantiated or unsubstantiated allegations of Staff-on-Inmate sexual assaults.

Data in this report reflects calendar year 2019: January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019

On December 31, 2019 the daily population was 829

The average daily population for the Prince William-Manassas Regional ADC in 2019 was 933

There were 9,681 commitments to the Prince William-Manassas Regional ADC in 2019
