Fun with Letters

Build with blocks: Children learn spatial relationships stacking and arranging blocks. Some blocks even have letters on them to recognize and name.

Trace shapes: Run your finger over a shape in a picture or book. Talk about how some shapes are the same and some are different.

Find the alphabet everywhere: You can point out the shapes of things that look like letters (like a "c" from the handle on a cup) or you can make letter shapes with your hands or bodies.

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
