# Amusement Device Permits/Inspections

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**Building Official** 

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The amusement device owner/operator will be responsible for hiring a Third-Party Virginia State Certified Amusement Device Inspector to conduct all inspections. In accordance with the <u>Building Development Fee Schedule</u> and the <u>Virginia Amusement Device Regulations</u>, all amusement device permit fees shall be reduced by 75% when a private Third-Party Inspector is used. Prince William County will perform Inflatable Amusement Device Inspections with the following exceptions:

## **Exception:**

- 1. Normal Business Hours A County Amusement Device Inspector will inspect up to Ten (10) Inflatable Amusement Devices during normal business hours.
- 2. Overtime Inspections If a County Amusement Device Inspector volunteers to conduct the inspections, after hours inspections are available per <u>Policy:</u> <u>Inspections Scheduling Overtime Inspections</u>.

## **Summary**

Following is a summary of the permit and inspection process:

- 1. **Submit Permit Application** In order to obtain a permit for an amusement device, the following is required:
  - A. The applicant must first obtain approval from the Zoning Administrator for the activity, the activity's location, and the dates on which the amusement devices will be used. Generally, either a <a href="Temporary Activity Permit">Temporary Activity Permit</a> (most carnivals except those operating at the County Fair Grounds in Manassas) or a Special Use Permit (permanent amusement facilities) will be required. Please contact the Office of Planning at 703-792-6830 for further information regarding either of these permits.
  - B. To obtain the permit from the Building Development Division for the construction, reassembly, operation and inspection of amusement devices, the following shall be submitted via the <u>ePortal</u> for review and approval:
    - Mechanical Permit Application The application must list the date of the
      event and names of the owner, lessee, or agent of either. The application, or
      separately supplied document, must provide the name of the person
      authorized to accept service of process on behalf of the owner or lessee.

- Amusement Device Certification Provide the list of amusement devices to be constructed/installed with each device's serial number. Label each device as Small Mechanical, Adult or Spectacular.
- Site Layout Plan Provide a site layout plan showing the location of the proposed amusement devices.
- Inspector Certification Provide a copy of the Third-Party Inspector's Virginia Amusement Device Certification and a contact telephone number.
- Liability Insurance Provide proof of liability insurance in accordance with the <u>Virginia Amusement Device Regulations</u>.
- Non-Destructive Testing Provide proof that non-destructive testing has been conducted. Testing for each amusement device must be conducted by a recognized agency, as prescribed by the device manufacturer, and in accordance with the applicable American Society for Testing Materials (ASTM) standards.
- Small Mechanical Rides and Inflatable Devices– If the Small Mechanical/Inflatable Device has an unexpired certificate of inspection (less than one year) by a local Building Department in Virginia, regardless of whether the ride has been disassembled or moved to a new site, a permit or inspection for a Kiddie Ride need not be obtained. However, in such cases, the Building Development Division shall be notified prior to operation through the submission of the <u>Inspected Small Mechanical Ride Verification</u>.
- 2. Private Inspector (Third Party Inspector)
  - Pre-Inspection Meeting Prior to conducting inspections, the Third-Party
    Inspector shall meet with a representative from the Building Construction
    Inspections Branch to present his/her Virginia Amusement Device Certification,
    review the inspection requirements and obtain the amusement device
    inspection stickers.
  - Submit Inspection Reports The Third-Party Inspector is required to complete
    an inspection report before the ride may be operated and submit it no later
    than the next business day. The report shall include the name and type of ride
    inspected, date and time of inspection, discrepancies found, the repairs made,
    and any ride that will not be put into operation because of the severity of
    discrepancies found.
- 3. Amusement Devices Requiring Annual Inspections
  - I. Inflatables (ASTM F2374)
    - Annual Inspections Required (Permit Required)
  - II. Go-Carts (ASTM F2007)
    - Bi-Annual Inspections Required from Date of Occupancy (Permit Required)

- III. Trampoline Courts (ASTM F2970)
  - Annual Inspections Required from date of Occupancy (Permit Required)
- IV. Artificial Climbing Walls (ASTM F1193)
  - Movable Climbing Walls do not require a permit if the device has a certificate if an inspected by a jurisdiction in the Commonwealth within 90 days and the expiration of the Wire Ropes do not expire with that 90 days
- 4. **Quality Control Inspection** During the event, the Building Development Division may perform unscheduled quality control inspections of the amusement devices and their operation.
- 5. Serious Injuries/Illnesses -
  - Serious Injuries/Illnesses means a personal injury/illness that results in death, dismemberment, significant disfigurement, permanent loss of the use of a body organ, member, function, or system, a compound fracture, or other significant injury/illness that requires immediate admission and overnight hospitalization and observation by a licensed physician.
  - Any injuries caused by an amusement device shall be reported to the Building Official and the Third-Party Inspector. The amusement device shall be taken out of service until investigated by a Prince William County Inspector.
