Insulation Inspections

Building Official Effective: February 18, 2002 Revised: May 1, 2022

The commercial building insulation shall be inspected and approved by a Building Inspector before a full Building Concealment Inspection Approval. The Building Insulation Inspection Code is 1150. The <u>Energy Envelope and Roof Covering Certification</u> is only allowed with Use Group R-2 and Use Group R-3 (e.g., condominiums; apartment buildings) in place of the Building Insulation Inspection.

The Building Insulation Inspection is required when the approved plans indicate insulation in the walls, ceilings, and/or roof systems. If additional insulation is installed that is not shown on the approved plans, the non-required insulation does not need to be inspected; however, the non-required insulation must be installed in accordance with the International Building Code.

The Building Inspector will mark the approved plans to indicate the Building Insulation Inspection Approvals. All areas requiring insulation, except for blown-in attic insulation, will have to be approved before issuing a full Building Concealment Approval. The blown-in attic insulation will be inspected during the Building Final Inspection.
