



Idenitification: Each person in the household (spouse, children, parents, etc.) must provide ID that includes the individual's date of birth. ID can be from any country. Examples include valid driver's license, Valid passport, birth certificate, valid state-issued ID, picture ID, valid student ID.

Proof of Address: Examples include current utility bill or some form of "official mail," voter registration card, USPS change of address confirmation.

Food is distributed twice a month (every 15 days). Education classes are offered with our partners who can also assist with the associated costs.

- (i) The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a U.S. government program that helps many low-income households with discounts for internet service and equipment costs. Prince William area residents can call or text their address to determine eligibility.

Eligibility criteria includes household income below 200% of the Federal Poverty Line, or if someone in the household currently receives a government benefit such as SNAP, Medicaid, SSI, WIC, Pell grant or free and reduced-price lunch.

- (i) Internet Essentials for only \$9.95/month plus tax with no contract and free equipment. Enrollment nroll in the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) to get service for free. Eligibility criteria includes qualification for programs such as National School Lunch Program, housing assistance, Medicaid, SNAP, SSI, Federal Pell Grant, and others. Must live in an area where Comcast Internet service is available and have not had Comcast Internet in the last 90 days.
