**Felony Child Abuse \*ARREST** – On June 8, both suspects, identified as Jakeline **SANCHEZ** and Richard Osmin **ASCENCIO**, who were sought in connection to the felony child abuse that was reported to have occurred at a residence located in the 4300 block of Granby Rd. in Woodbridge (22193) on January 22, 2023, turned themselves in to police.

**Felony Child Abuse [Previously Released]** – On June 4, 2024, detectives concluded an investigation into the neglect of a 19-month-old boy after police had responded to a residence located in the 4300 block of Granby Rd. in Woodbridge (22193) on January 22, 2023. The child was found unresponsive by fire & rescue services and subsequently transported to an area hospital where he was pronounced deceased. During the course of the investigation, an autopsy was completed which showed signs of suspected abuse by the child’s parents, identified as the two accused. The child’s cause of death has not been determined by the Medical Examiner’s Office. On June 4, 2024, following the investigation and upon consultation with the Commonwealth’s Attorney’s Office, detectives obtained arrest warrants for both accused, identified as Jakeline **SANCHEZ** and Richard Osmin **ASCENCIO**. Attempts to locate the two accused have been unsuccessful.

## Incidents

**Armed Robberies** – On June 7 at 11:23PM, officers responded to the area of Cherry Hill Rd. and Thoroughgood Dr. in Dumfries (22026) to investigate two robberies. The investigation revealed the victims, two 18-year-old men, were walking in the above area when a dark-colored vehicle with tinted windows stopped near them. Multiple masked occupants got out of the vehicle and demanded one of the victim's property. The suspects took the victim's phone and camera before the victim ran from the scene. The suspects then demanded the second victim's property and when the victim refused, the suspects brandished firearms. The suspects took jewelry, shoes, clothing, and a phone before quickly driving out of the area. No injuries were reported. No additional suspect description was provided.

**Armed Robbery** – On June 7 at 4:51PM, officers responded to Potomac Mills located at 2700 Potomac Mills Cl. in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a 16-year-old male juvenile, and two female juvenile acquaintances were in a public restroom when one of the females allowed two additional males into the restroom. While inside the restroom, one of the males grabbed the victim and brandished a firearm before taking the victim's property. The victim eventually fled the restroom and contacted the police. No injuries were reported. While investigating the incident, officers recovered all of the victim's property except a pair of shoes. The parties involved are believed to be known to one another, and the incident does not appear to be random. No charges have been obtained at this time.

**Assault by Mob | Brandishing of a Firearm** – On June 9 at 12:18AM, officers responded to investigate an assault that occurred at a residence in the 4600 block of Woodway Pl. in Woodbridge (22193) earlier that evening. The investigation revealed the victim, a 17-year-old male juvenile, and an acquaintance were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated while at the above residence for a social gathering. At some point during the encounter, the two males entered a second room where multiple unknown men then brandished firearms towards the victim. One of the men physically struck the victim with a firearm before the victim ran out of the residence. The acquaintance followed the victim and tackled him to the ground while outside. The other men followed outside and then a separate unknown man approached and brandished a firearm towards the victim before all of the parties separated. The victim was later treated at an area hospital for non-life threatening injuries and the police were contacted. The investigation continues as officers attempt to identify all of the parties involved in the incident.

**Sexual Assault Investigation** – On June 10, detectives concluded an investigation into a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred at a residence in the Nokesville (20181) area of Prince William County sometime between May 1 and June 5. The investigation revealed the victim, who was under the age of 15, during the above timeframe, was sexually assaulted by the accused, who was known to the victim. Following the investigation, detectives obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Arturo **GOMEZ TORIBIO**. Attempts to locate the accused have been unsuccessful.



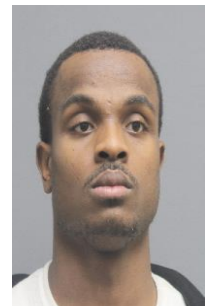

**Abduction (Domestic Related)** – On June 7 at 12:19PM, officers responded to the Woodbridge Station Apartments located in the 1300 block of Eisenhower Cl. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed the victim, a 22-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused struck the victim and physically prevented her from the room. When a 33-year-old female family member intervened, the accused brandished a firearm before leaving the apartment. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Jamari **ANKRAH**. Attempts to locate the accused have been unsuccessful.

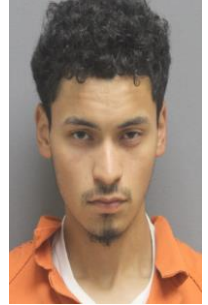

## Arrests

**Abduction (Domestic Related)** – On June 9 at 10:18PM, officers responded to the Westgate Apartments located in the 8000 block of Ashland Ave. in Manassas (20109) to investigate a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed the victim, a 22-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused briefly grabbed the victim’s wrist before letting go. The accused then followed the victim to her vehicle where he got on top of her vehicle and prevented her from leaving. Responding officers located the accused in the parking lot and when they attempted to detain him, he actively resisted before being detained without further incident. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Abner Edgardo **DE LAO**, was arrested.

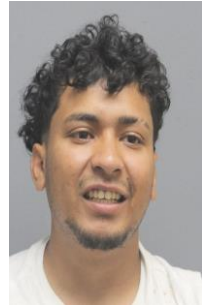

**Assault & Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]** – On June 9 at 1:09AM, officers initiated a vehicle stop in the area of Sudley Manor Dr. and Copeland Dr. in Manassas (20109) for a traffic infraction. The driver of the vehicle, later identified as the accused, initially disregarded the officer's emergency equipment and eventually stopped in the area of Colton Ln. and Copeland Dr. Officer's made contact with the accused and determined he was intoxicated and driving without a valid driver's license. When officers attempted to detain the accused, he actively resisted and refused to follow officers' commands. After a brief struggle, where the accused struck an officer in the head, the accused was taken into custody without further incident. Minor injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Davis Esau **LOPEZ PORTILLO**, was arrested.
