Incidents

Shooting Investigation – On June 13 at 3:00PM, officers responded to the Woodwind Villa Apartments located in the 14500 block of Piccolo Ln. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shooting. Responding officers located a 31-year-old man suffering from a gunshot wound in the 1440 block of Richmond Hwy. and provided first aid. Fire and rescue personnel responded and transported the victim to an area hospital with a non-life threatening injury. The investigation revealed an initial shooting occurred on a nearby walking path before multiple individuals were seen running from the path. Shortly after a second shooting incident occurred involving the victim and two unknown men. The victim ran towards Richmond Hwy. where he was located suffering from a gunshot wound. The other two men ran from the area before police arrived on scene. While investigating the incident, officers located two separate apartments that were struck by gunfire and shell casings. No additional injuries or property damage were reported. The victim refused to cooperate further with detectives regarding the incident. **Anyone with information that could aid investigators in this investigation is asked to contact police.**

Brandishing of a Firearm – On June 14 at 12:41AM, officers responded to the Popeyes located at 14400 Richmond Hwy. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a brandishing. The investigation revealed while outside of the business, a 23-year-old employee was involved in a verbal altercation with an unknown man that escalated. During the encounter, the suspect brandished a firearm before the victim went back into the business and contacted the police. No shots were fired.

Suspect description:

A black male between 20-22 years old

Last seen wearing a black jacket tied on his head, a white tank top, and long black pants
