Malicious Wounding *ARREST – On June 20, the suspect, identified as Michael **NELSON**, who was sought in connection to the malicious wounding that was reported to have occurred at a residence located in the 3000 block of Antrim Cl. in Dumfries (22025) on June 15, was arrested in Fairfax County.

Malicious Wounding [Previously Released] – On June 16 at 10:38AM, officers responded to investigate a domestic dispute that was reported to have occurred at a residence located in the 3000 block of Antrim Cl. in Dumfries (22025) on June 15 around 10:45PM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 34-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused struck, kicked, and bit the victim before grabbing her neck. The accused left the residence and took the victim's phone, preventing her from calling the police. Minor injuries were reported. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Michael **NELSON.** Attempts to locate the accused have been unsuccessful.

Commercial Burglary – On June 24 at 8:20AM, officers responded to the Pet Supplies Plus store located at 7859 Sudley Rd. in Manassas (20109) to investigate a burglary. Video surveillance revealed an individual used a rock to shatter the front bottom window of the store. The suspect then entered the store and damaged a cash register before leaving. No property was reported missing. The suspect was last seen wearing a white sweatshirt, black gloves, grey pants, white/grey shoes and carrying a grey backpack.

Attempted Residential Burglary – On June 24 at 1:45PM, officers responded to investigate an attempted burglary that was reported to have occurred at the Ravens Crest Apartments located in the 11000 block of Edgepark Cl. in Manassas (20109) between 12:00AM and 1:00AM on June 23. The investigation revealed a man attempted to gain entry into the apartment through the sliding glass door which was secured. No entry was made into the apartment and no property was reported missing.

Arrests

Residential Burglary – On June 21 at 11:18AM, officers responded to investigate a burglary that was reported to have occurred at the Dale Forest Apartments located in the 4300 block of Welsh Ln. in Woodbridge (22193) on the morning of June 20. The investigation revealed the accused was with a group of other individuals in the apartment complex when an apartment was forcibly entered. The group eventually left the area with an electric bike that was taken from the balcony. Later that day, the accused pawned the bicycle at a local business. While investigating the incident, officers observed the accused



in the apartment complex where they were detained without incident. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Diego Alberto **MUNOZ-VILLEDA**, was arrested. The investigation continues as officers attempt to identify the other individuals involved in the incident.
