

# Guide on how to obtain a Virginia state-issued ID

A state-issued ID card includes the person's photo and name, and may include date of birth, address, height, weight, and hair color.

### Types of State-Issued ID

#### • Driver's License

A Virginia driver's license allows you to legally operate a motor vehicle. It is generally valid for up to eight years, and includes important identifying information such as your full name, birthdate, mailing address and photograph. You must be at least 16 years and three months old to apply for a driver's license. Learner's Permit or completed driving course is required before being eligible for a driver's license.

#### • Adult ID Card

Adult ID cards are issued to individuals age 15 and above who do not hold a learner's permit or driver's license issued by any state within the United States.

#### • Child ID Card

Parents can obtain ID cards for their children under age 15 at any <u>DMV customer</u> service center.

### • Hearing Impaired Indicator

If you have a hearing impairment and do not hold a learner's permit or driver's license issued from any state within the United States, you may obtain a hearing impaired identification card. This ID card is the same as an adult ID card except that it bears the notation "Hearing Impaired ID". It does not provide special privileges, but does indicate that you have a hearing impairment.

### • Veteran Indicator

 If you're a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces, you may add the word "Veteran" to your driver's license or ID card. This lets you show your veteran status at retailers and restaurants that offer veteran discounts.

## Typical Steps for Replacing a State-Issued ID

- Virginia State Requirements and information at <a href="https://www.dmv.virginia.gov/">https://www.dmv.virginia.gov/</a>
- Prepare the application: At the link above, choose the ID you want to apply for, download & complete the application on paper, determine which documents will be needed.
- Find the <u>nearest DMV location</u> to take your application and required documents to get your ID.

#### Costs

- Driver's License \$32 for a standard eight-year license
- Adult ID Card \$2 per year (minimum \$10; maximum \$16)
- Child ID Card \$2 per year (minimum \$10; maximum \$16)
