**RE: REALLOCATE \$1,986,922 OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS WITHIN THE COVID-19 SPECIAL REVENUE FUND TO SUPPORT THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FEEDING TASK FORCE BY PROVIDING AN ADDITIONAL \$190,000 TO THE NORTHERN VIRGINIA FOOD RESCUE FOR FOOD DISTRIBUTION AND RELATED ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS; \$100,000 FOR THE COUNTY TO PURCHASE ADDITIONAL FOOD INVENTORY FOR COMMUNITY FEEDING; AN ADDITIONAL \$100,000 TO THE HUMAN SERVICES ALLIANCE OF GREATER PRINCE WILLIAM; AND TO SUPPORT THE COMMUNITY SAFETY INITIATIVE BY PROVIDING \$270,400 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF COMMUNITY-CENTRIC SAFETY STRATEGIES, WITH AN EMPHASIS ON COMMUNITY VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION; AND TRANSFER, BUDGET, AND APPROPRIATE AN ADDITIONAL \$1,326,522 OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS FROM THE COVID-19 SPECIAL REVENUE FUND TO THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND FOR ADDITIONAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE JUDICIAL CENTER RENOVATION PROJECT**

**ACTION: APPROVED**

**WHEREAS**, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 was passed by Congress on March 10, 2021, and signed into law on March 11, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, Prince William County received \$91,357,060 from ARPA's Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (CSLFRF) to aid in the recovery of lost revenues and from the public health and economic impacts caused by the COVID-19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, during Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 through FY 2024 to date, the Prince William Board of County Supervisors (Board) passed several resolutions to accept, budget, appropriate, allocate, and reallocate all ARPA CSLFRF to various eligible projects and sub-recipients; and

**WHEREAS**, \$1,986,922 of ARPA CSLFRF funding is now available in the COVID-19 Special Revenue Fund;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Prince William Board of County Supervisors hereby reallocates \$1,986,922 of American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds within the COVID-19 Special Revenue Fund to support the American Rescue Plan Act Feeding Task Force by providing an additional \$190,000 to the Northern Virginia Food Rescue for food distribution and related administrative costs; \$100,000 for the County to purchase additional food inventory for community feeding; an additional \$100,000 to the Human Services Alliance of Greater Prince William; and to support the Community Safety Initiative by providing \$270,400 for the development of community-centric safety strategies, with an emphasis on community violence prevention and intervention; and transfer, budget and appropriate an additional \$1,326,522 of American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds from the COVID-19 Special Revenue Fund to the Capital Projects Fund for additional costs associated with the Judicial Center Renovation project.
