

FINAL CERTIFICATION
OF EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE AND ELECTION RESULTS FOR
PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY POLICE BARGAINING UNIT

A secret ballot election was held by electronic ballot pursuant to the Prince William County Collective Bargaining Ordinance (the “Ordinance”). The election was held to determine whether employees of Prince William County within the Police Bargaining Unit, as defined in the Ordinance, will be represented by the Prince William County Police Association as Exclusive Representative for collective bargaining under the Ordinance. The vote was counted on March 24, 2023, by the impartial election services provider engaged by the Parties. The publication of the results was witnessed by the Interim Labor Relations Administrator; by representatives of Prince William County; and by representatives of the Prince William County Police Association.


The ballot question was: “Do you wish to be represented for purposes of collective bargaining by the Prince William County Police Association?”

Of the ballots cast, 184 voted “Yes”; 2 voted “No.”

The Prince William County Police Association received a majority of the votes cast in the election. No objections to the election were filed within the 14 days after the service of the report and initial certification of results, and issuance of a final determination certifying the election results and the Exclusive Representative is now appropriate.

This represents my final determination, under the Prince William County Collective Bargaining Ordinance, certifying the Prince William County Police Association as the Exclusive Representative for the Police Bargaining Unit.
