

FINAL CERTIFICATION OF  
EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE AND ELECTION RESULTS FOR  
PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY FIRE AND RESCUE BARGAINING UNIT

A secret ballot election was held by electronic ballot pursuant to the Prince William County Collective Bargaining Ordinance (the “Ordinance”). The election was held to determine whether employees of Prince William County within the Fire and Rescue Bargaining Unit, as defined in the Ordinance, will be represented by Prince William Professional Fire Fighters Local 2598 as Exclusive Representative for collective bargaining under the Ordinance. The vote was counted on April 12, 2023, by the impartial election services provider engaged by the Parties. The publication of the results was witnessed by the Interim Labor Relations Administrator; by representatives of Prince William County; and by representatives of Prince William Professional Fire Fighters Local 2598.


The ballot question was: “Do you wish to be represented for purposes of collective bargaining by Prince William Professional Fire Fighters Local 2598?”

Of the ballots cast, 355 voted “Yes”; 3 voted “No.”

Prince William Professional Fire Fighters Local 2598 received a majority of the votes cast in the election. No objections to the election were filed within the 14 days after the service of the report and initial certification of results, and issuance of a final determination certifying the election results and the Exclusive Representative is now appropriate.

This represents my final determination, under the Prince William County Collective Bargaining Ordinance, certifying Prince William Professional Fire Fighters Local 2598 as the Exclusive Representative for the Fire and Rescue Bargaining Unit.
