Strong-Arm Robbery | Assault by Mob *ARREST – On November 6, officers obtained charges for one of the suspects, identified as a **15-year-old male juvenile**, sought in connection to the robbery that was reported to have occurred in the 7600 block of Michelle Ct. in Manassas (20109) on October 30. The investigation continues as officers attempt to identify the other suspects involved in the incident.

Strong-Arm **Robbery | Assault by Mob [Previously Released] -** On October 30 at 8:22PM, officers responded to the 7600 block of Michelle Ct. in Manassas (20109) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a 17-year-old male juvenile, was approached by a group of unknown males, possibly teenagers. During the encounter, the suspects assaulted the victim before taking his backpack and phone. The victim was eventually able to separate from the suspects and went to a nearby home where police were contacted. Officers and a police K-9 searched the area for the suspects who were not located. Minor injuries were reported.

Attempted Carjacking – On November 5 at 8:34PM, officers responded to the 14800 block of Winding Loop in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an attempted carjacking. The investigation revealed the victim, a 40-year-old man, was sitting inside his vehicle in a parking lot when he was approached by an unknown man. During the encounter, the man brandished a firearm and demanded the victim exit the vehicle. An acquaintance of the victim, a 34-year-old man, who seated in the passenger seat, exited the vehicle and physically confronted the suspect who eventually left on foot. No injuries were reported. A police K-9 searched the area for the suspect who was not located.

Suspect Description:

Black male, early to mid-20s, 6'2", 180lbs with a thin build, shoulder-length black dreadlocks, brown eyes, and a beard

Last seen wearing gray sweatpants and a light-colored shirt

Strangulation | **Abduction** (**Domestic**) - On November 5 at 11:38AM, officers responded to investigate an assault that was reported to have occurred at a residence located in the 7500 block of Purdue Ct in Manassas (20109) earlier that morning. The investigation revealed the victim, a 27-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused physically assaulted the victim, and at one point, grabbed her by the neck after he took the victim's phone when she attempted to call police. The suspect also precented the victim from leaving the residence. The parties eventually separated,



and the victim left the home to contact police. Minor injuries were reported. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Ta-equan Marquis **HILL**. Attempts to locate the accused were unsuccessful.

Brandishing of a Firearm – On November 5 at 7:36PM, officers responded to the area of Minnieville Rd and Smoketown Rd in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a brandishing. The investigation revealed the victims, a 27-year-old man and 20-year-old woman, were involved in a road rage incident with the driver of a white Ford F-150 while driving in the above area. During the encounter, the other driver pointed a firearm at the victims before driving off. No shots were fired, and no injuries were reported. The driver was only described as a black male, bald, wearing a white t-shirt.
