Incidents

Armed Robbery – On November 13 at 7:45PM, officers responded to the CJKK Bridal located at 14439 Richmond Highway in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed an unknown man demanded money from an employee while brandishing a knife. The suspect fled the store with an undisclosed amount of money. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a black male wearing a ski-style mask, black sweatshirt, black sweatpants, and light-colored sneakers.

Residential Burglary – On November 13 at 9:36AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 10800 block of Violet Ct. in Manassas (20109) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed sometime between 6:30AM and 9:30AM, entry was made into the home through an unsecured front door. An undisclosed amount of money and home goods were reported missing.

Assault & Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO] – On November 13 at 10:10PM, officers responded to 5500 block of Hope Hill Ave. in Woodbridge (22193) to assist a person in crisis. During their contact with a woman, later identified as the accused, she began to yell and actively resist. The accused struck one officer and kicked another officer before being detained without further incident. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Elizabeth Lynn **HEARD**, was arrested.
