Step 2. Submit volunteer application with a one-time fee of \$50 (pay in cash, check, or money order.) Kindly be aware that fees will apply for any returned checks.

Step 3. Observe an entire virtual course. One night a week for seven weeks. Time: 6:50 PM to 9:00 PM

Step 4. Complete classroom training.

Successfully complete eight hours of inperson training at 8033 Ashton Ave, Manassas.

Complete a two hours on-line civil rights training.

Here's what you can expect as a Volunteer Parent Educator:

- Teach a two hour virtual class series, one night a week for seven consecutive weeks.
- Flexible on-line teaching schedule.
- Teach two class series annually.
- Ongoing support and mentorship.
- The opportunity to connect with and empower parents in the community.
