On December 6, the suspect, identified as Anthony James **GABLER-PINEDA**, was located and taken into custody by Arlington County police. The investigation continues as detectives attempt to identify the other suspects involved in the incident.

Shooting Investigation [Previously Released] – On October 12 at 3:37PM, officers responded to the 11100 block of Bulloch Dr in Manassas (20109) to investigate a shooting. The investigation revealed the victim, a 19-year-old man, made arrangements over social media to sell a pair of shoes to an unknown party in the parking lot of the above area. During the encounter, the victim was shot in the upper body. The suspect vehicle left the area at a high rate of speed towards I-66. The victim was rerated at an area hospital for non-life threatening injuries. No other injuries or property damage were reported. The vehicle was described as a black Infiniti G37 with dark wheels and tinted windows.

Shooting Investigation | Armed Robbery - On December 9 at 7:03PM, officers responded to investigate a shooting that was reported to have occurred in the area of Forestdale Ave. near Dale Blvd. in Woodbridge (22193) earlier that evening. The investigation revealed the victim, a 27-year-old man, arranged to meet with a woman he met over Tinder. As the victim was walking in the area, he approached by two unknown men. During the encounter, one of the men brandished a firearm and fired a round, striking the victim. The suspects then assaulted the victim and took his property before fleeing the area. The victim left the area and eventually went to an area hospital where police were contacted. Jewelry and clothing were reported missing. No additional injuries or property damage were reported.
