Felony Child Neglect | Assault & Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO] – On March 11 at 7:39PM, officers responded to the Somerset Pointe Apartments located in the 14700 block of Soapstone Dr. in Gainesville (20155) to investigate a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed a verbal altercation had occurred before the involved parties, including the accused, left the apartment leaving three children under the age of 10 unsupervised. The accused eventually returned to the apartment and was detained by officers. The living conditions of the apartment were found to be unsafe and potentially



hazardous to the children. When officers attempted to detain the accused, she actively resisted and kicked multiple officers several times, bit another officer, and attempted to grab an officer's holstered weapon.
