### Updates

**Fatal Hit & Run Crash Investigation \*ADDITIONAL INVESTIGATIVE DETAILS** – While continuing to investigate the fatal hit and run crash that occurred in the area of Richmond Hwy. near Easy St. in Woodbridge (22191) on March 20, crash investigators obtained additional information about the striking vehicle that fled the area and left a 53-year-old man dead. The vehicle is believed to be a 2018-2025 dark in color Toyota Camry with damage to the front left bumper and fender area of the vehicle. **Crash investigators are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash or who has information about the striking vehicle or its driver, to contact police.** The investigation continues.

**Identified:**

The deceased pedestrian was identified as Miles Jonathan **MOORE**, 53, of Woodbridge

**Fatal Hit & Run Crash Investigation [Previously Released]** – On March 20 at 9:03PM, officers responded to the area of Richmond Hwy. near Easy St. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an unconscious man in the roadway. The investigation revealed the driver of a 2012 Toyota Highlander was traveling southbound on Richmond Hwy. when the vehicle struck a pedestrian who was attempting to cross Richmond Hwy. outside of a crosswalk. The pedestrian was then struck by a separate unknown vehicle that was also traveling southbound on Richmond Hwy. The pedestrian was transported to an area hospital where he died from injuries sustained in the collisions. The driver of the Toyota remained at the scene and was uninjured. No further information on the unknown driver or striking vehicle is available at this time. **Investigators with the Crash Investigation Unit are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash to contact police.** The investigation continues.

## Incidents

**Fatal Crash Investigation** – On March 16 at 11:32PM, officers responded to the Citgo gas station located at 1320 Old Bridge Rd. in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a vehicle crash involving a pedestrian. The investigation revealed the driver of a 2014 Toyota Camry was exiting the fuel pump area towards Gordon Blvd. when the vehicle struck a pedestrian who was walking around the fuel pump island. The pedestrian fell to the ground and was run over by the vehicle. The pedestrian was extracted by fire & rescue and transported to an area hospital where he later died from his injuries on March 25. The driver of the striking vehicle remained at the scene. No additional injuries were reported and no charges have been placed at this time as the investigation continues. **Crash investigators are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash to contact police.**

***Identified:***

The pedestrian was identified as Jeffrey Wayne **HOLMAN**, 56, of Woodbridge

**Armed Robbery** – On March 25 at 1:09PM, officers responded to the Potomac Ridge Apartments located in the 2800 block of Woodmark Dr. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a 26-year-old man, arranged to sell jewelry to an unknown individual via Facebook Marketplace. Before the sale was completed, the buyer brandished a firearm toward the victim and took the jewelry before leaving the area. A second unknown man joined the suspect as he ran from parking lot. No injuries were reported.

***Suspect Descriptions:***

A black male, in his early 20's, approximately 6'0, with a Medium Athletic Build

Last seen wearing a blue surgical-style mask, a black fitted cap and hooded sweatshirt, silver bracelet, newer black Balenciaga Track Runner Shoes

A black male, in his early 20's, between 5'6-5'8, with a thin build

Last seen wearing all black colored clothing
