### Incidents

**Malicious Wounding [Domestic]** – On March 26 at 11:36PM, officers responded to the Riverside Station Apartments located in the 14000 block of Big Crest Ln. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed the victim, a 28-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused struck and kicked the victim multiple times before physically preventing her from leaving the residence. The accused took the victim's money and phone before leaving the apartment. The victim was treated at an area hospital for non-life threatening injuries. Officers and a police K-9 searched the area for the accused who was not located. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Elisha Herbert **WILLIAMS**. Further attempts to locate the accused have been unsuccessful.

**Shooting into an Occupied Vehicle** – On March 26 at 11:28PM, officers responded to the area of Cardinal Dr. and Stockholm Way in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed the victim, a 41-year-old woman, was driving in the above area sometime between 12:00PM – 1:00PM when she heard a loud noise. Later that day, damage was found to the vehicle appearing to be from a bullet or other projectile. No injuries or additional property damage were reported.

**Attempted Residential Burglary** – On March 26 at 5:11PM, officers responded to The Woods at Victoria Park Apartments located in the 16800 block of Flotilla Way in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an attempted burglary. The investigation revealed sometime between 9:00AM and 12:00PM, forced entry was attempted into the apartment through the front door which appeared tampered with. No entry was made into the apartment, and no property was reported missing.

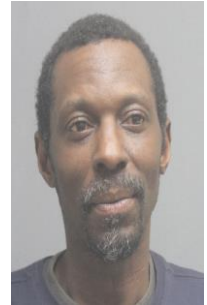

**Strangulation [Domestic]** – On March 25 at 10:16PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 1900 block of Inglebrook Dr. in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed the victim, a 41-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused held the victim down and grabbed her neck before the parties separated. Non-life threatening injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Rashawn Kenyatta **KING**, was arrested.
