Strangulation [Domestic] - On March 29 at 10:10PM, officers responded to the Coverstone IV Apartments located in the 7600 block of Cass Pl. in Manassas (20109) to investigate a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed the victim, a 27-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused grabbed the victim and threw her to the ground before grabbing her neck. At one point, the accused retrieved a knife and threatened the victim. The parties separated, and the victim contacted the police. Non-life threatening injuries were reported. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Micah Emmanuel **RAGIN.** Attempts to locate the accused have been unsuccessful.

Armed Robbery -On March 30 at 12:22AM, officers responded to the Coverstone IV Apartments located in the 7600 block of Croce Ct. in Manassas (20109) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a 21-year-old man, arranged to sell clothing to an unknown buyer via Instagram. Before the transaction was completed, the buyer brandished a firearm and demanded the victim's property. A second unknown man approached and took the victim's property before both suspects left the area. No injuries were reported. Officers and a police K-9 searched the area for the suspects who were not located. Clothing, money, and a firearm were reported missing.

The investigation revealed multiple shots were heard in the above area before a red sedan was seen leaving the area. No injuries or property damage were reported.
